THE FINE PRINT: All Championship categories are open to category 1-4 riders. Cat 4 Men may choose to race in the Championship event or the non-championship 4/5 event. Cat 5 Men and Cat 4 Women racers may not race the championship events but are eligible for a shot at the money. A 2012 Road USA Cycling racing license will be required to enter any of the championship events. One-Day licenses for the non-championship events are \$10. **First racer off at 8:00am, rider starts will be in 30 second intervals.** Start list will be at registration.

COURSE: State Route 207 from the intersection of Foothill Road to Daggett Summit commonly referred to as [Kingsbury Grade](#). Starting elevation is 4800', finishing elevation is 7300', **total ascent is 2550' in 7.9 miles** with an average grade of 6.1%. Current course record is 32:59 by Paul Mach. Pavement is in good condition with most of the climb having decent shoulder. Traffic is moderate, but should be minimal early on a Sunday morning. Riders must follow all regular traffic laws during the race and on the return down the hill. Helmets required.

AWARDS: \$1000 cash purse to the 3 fastest men(\$600) and 3 fastest women(\$400) regardless of category. USAC State Championship medals to 3 places in all championship categories. Non-Championship categories will get awards. There will be a podium ceremony at the start after all riders are off the hill.

REGISTRATION: \$30 to pre-register for all categories. \$10 late fee to register on site. Online registration is available until 8pm PST on Friday 8/10 at www.bikereg.com for a small surcharge. Race day registration opens at 6:30 am and closes at 7:45am.

DIRECTIONS: The start will be at the intersection of SR 207 and Foothill Road. Parking will be in the Park and Ride across 207 and parallel parking where appropriate along Foothill Road either north or south of the intersection.
